The **Public Meeting** will provide a brief overview of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's review process for nuclear power plants that request to operate for 20 years beyond their current license expiration date. The meeting will also allow the public to provide comments on the environmental scoping of the Limerick plant. The staff wishes to hear about unique aspects, significant issues, and other projects in the area surrounding the Limerick plant from the local constituents. This will allow the staff to complete a comprehensive and in-depth review of the environmental impacts of allowing the plant to operate for an additional 20 years.

The **Open House** invites interested members of the public to meet with NRC staff on an informal basis to ask questions. Scoping comments will not be accepted during the open house.
