



Perkiomen Township was notified that on or about Monday, April 2, 2018 work will resume on Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's S.R. 4044 Project. The work will affect Perkiomen Township in two areas:

- **PLANK ROAD**: April 2, through late June - Plank Road will be closed from Route 29 to the entrance of the Central Perkiomen Valley Park. Plank Road will be closed and detoured between Route 29 (Gravel Pike) and Route 73 (Skippack Pike) in Perkiomen and Skippack Townships. During this construction, access to the Central Perkiomen Valley Park will be from the Route 73 side of Plank Road **ONLY**. Plank Road motorists will be directed to use Route 29 (Gravel Pike) and Route 73 (Skippack Pike).
- **SEITZ ROAD**: April 2, through late September - Seitz Road will be closed from Meyers Road to Fox Heath Boulevard. The portion of Meyers Road (Formerly known as Seitz Road) will be opened to Township Line Road. During a small portion of this phase of the project, Fox Heath Boulevard may be closed at Seitz Road to make improvements at this intersection. At this point in time, it is unknown when and how long this intersection may be closed. We will attempt to notify the public in advanced when Fox Heath Boulevard is to be closed.
- Meanwhile, Ott Road will remain closed and detoured between Miller Road and Route 29 (Gravel Pike) in Perkiomen Township through May 2019.
