PERKIOMEN TOWNSHIP

Perkiomen Township awarded a contract for the proposed road work to be completed in 2020. On or about June 22, 2020, the contractor will begin the work on this project. Below is a summary of the proposed road work:

ROAD PROJECTS

MAPLE HILL COMMUNITY:

Lexington Road - Portions of the existing storm sewer pipe will be removed and replaced with new pipe. This pipe will be connected into the existing inlets. Stormwater work may require temporary roadway closure. The roadway will then be repaired and overlaid with new bituminous paving. The speed hump will be reinstalled in its existing location.

Concord Road – Portions of the existing storm sewer pipe will be replaced with new pipe. Several existing storm sewer inlets will be replaced with new inlets. Stormwater work may require temporary roadway closure. The roadway will then be repaired and overlaid with new bituminous paving.

Salem Road - Portions of the existing storm sewer pipe will be replaced with new pipe. Several existing storm sewer inlets will be replaced with new inlets. Stormwater work may require temporary roadway closure. The roadway will then be repaired and overlaid with new bituminous paving. The two speed humps will be reinstalled in their existing locations.

Please note that roadways within the Maple Hill Community may be closed to through traffic during the storm sewer improvements. Residents who live on the above streets will be given vehicular access to their homes; however, it may be only in one direction. Temporary traffic closures on individual streets are anticipated to collectively last 2 to 4 weeks; they will be restricted to one street at a time.

On-street parking will be eliminated during the storm sewer and paving improvements requiring the temporarily relocation of parking during the working hours of 7am-4pm. Notices will be posted as construction progresses. Please plan accordingly.



CHETWIN FARMS:

Panepinto Drive - The roadway surface will be milled to a depth of 1.5". Failing portions of the road base will be removed and replaced. The roadway will then be overlaid with new bituminous paving.

Roman Drive (Includes Emergency Access) - The roadway surface will be milled to a depth of 1.5". Failing portions of the road base will be removed and replaced. The roadway will then be overlaid with new bituminous paving.

Please note that on-street parking within Chetwin Farms will be eliminated for the duration of active portion of the project. Please plan accordingly.

SCHOOLHOUSE ROAD (TRAPPE ROAD TO PAVING JOINT)

Failing portions of the road base will be removed and replaced. The roadway will then be overlaid with new bituminous paving.

TRAPPE ROAD (ADAMS LANE TO BETCHER ROAD)

Failing portions of the road base will be removed and replaced. The roadway will then be overlaid with new bituminous paving.

Traffic control patterns may result in one-lane operation utilizing flaggers. This will result in location based traffic delays during the working hours of 7:00 am and 4:00 pm. There will also be limited access to/from driveways at times. The contractor will advise you of driveway access restrictions. It is anticipated that the overall project will take approximately six to eight weeks.

This is a necessary and temporary inconvenience in order for us to maintain our roadways and stormwater infrastructure. Perkiomen Township thanks you in advance for your cooperation.
